DESCRIPTION OF THE HOTEL

Welcome to Hotel Vildbjerg, which is located in the small and cosy town, Vildbjerg, between Holstebro and Herning. The hotel has existed for 130 years and consists of 33 bright rooms all with bathroom en suite, TV, radio and free wireless internet. The hotel has a cosy inn lounge and restaurant with a large glass façade facing the street. The restaurant places importance on good Danish cuisine and has a varied à la carte menu.

SUGGESTIONS FOR EXCURSIONS

Until 1962, brown coal was excavated in Abildå Brunkulsleje (brown coal field). By arrangement, you can see former brown coal workers recreate the work of excavating brown coal. The exciting nature area is worth a walk and you can also enjoy your packed lunch. Trehøje Museum is showing a large collection of locally collected workshop environments as well as some farming tools from when real horse power was used. Have a guided tour of Møltrup Communit Home - residential accommodation where, among other things, the residents keep animals, have a butchery and a food shop where the products from the home are sold. Vildbjerg is centrally located in relation to the surrounding larger towns: Herning, Holstebro and Ringkøbing, which offer everything from culture, sports to a cosy market town atmosphere.
